
## show me the money







## Know your money (classroom activity A)

Activity	Time	Objective	Description
Introduction	3 minutes		• Explain how important it is to know the difference between U.S. coins and bills so we can use money correctly.
Discussion	7 minutes	To identify the different U.S. coins and main parts of a dollar bill	<ul> <li>Discuss with the students the difference between coins and bills.</li> <li>Show them some examples of different coins and bills (have them tell you the name and the amount of each).</li> </ul>
Classroom Activity	8 minutes	To reinforce the concepts taught in this lesson through hands-on activities.	<ul> <li>Hand out the Know Your Money activity sheets.</li> <li>Have the students work on the sheets individually or in a group.</li> <li>Walk through the instructions of the first part of the activity (number one), then walk through one example as a class and let the students begin working.</li> <li>Walk through the instructions of the second part of the activity (number two), then walk through one example as a class and let the students begin working.</li> </ul>
Conclusion	2 minutes		<ul> <li>Ask the students a few questions to review the lesson.</li> <li>Explain how important it is for them to know the different names and amounts of each coin and bill so they can use them correctly.</li> </ul>
