| Activity | Time | Objective | Description |

| Introduction | 3 minutes |  | - Explain how important it is to know the difference between U.S. coins and bills so we can use money correctly. |
| Discussion | 7 minutes | To identify the different U.S. coins and main parts of a dollar bill | - Discuss with the students the difference between coins and bills. <br> - Show them some examples of different coins and bills (have them tell you the name and the amount of each). |
| Classroom Activity | 8 minutes | To reinforce the concepts taught in this lesson through hands-on activities. | - Hand out the Know Your Money activity sheets. <br> - Have the students work on the sheets individually or in a group. <br> - Walk through the instructions of the first part of the activity (number one), then walk through one example as a class and let the students begin working. <br> - Walk through the instructions of the second part of the activity (number two), then walk through one example as a class and let the students begin working. |
| Conclusion | 2 minutes |  | - Ask the students a few questions to review the lesson. <br> - Explain how important it is for them to know the different names and amounts of each coin and bill so they can use them correctly. |
