Activity	Time	Objective	Description
Introduction	3 minutes		Explain how important it is to know how to count our money and make the correct change.
Discussion	7 minutes	To learn how to combine the correct amount of coins and bills to pay for an item.	 Discuss with the students how we use coins and bills together to add up to the total cost of an item. Walk through one example with the entire class about how various denominations can be added to reach a total (for example, one dollar bill, two quarters and one nickel can pay for a \$1.55 fruit cup).
Classroom Activity	8 minutes	To reinforce the concepts taught in this lesson through hands-on activities.	 Hand out the How Much? activity sheets. Have the students work on the sheets individually or in a group. Walk through the instructions of the activity, then walk through one example as a class and let the students begin working.
Conclusion	2 minutes		 Ask the students a few questions to review the lesson. Explain how important it is for them to know how to count the correct amount of money when purchasing items.
