Activity	Time	Objective	Description
Introduction	3 minutes		 Explain how important it is for us to save our money for the future. Explain how important it is for us to save our money in a safe place where it will not get lost, damaged or stolen.
Discussion	7 minutes	To learn the importance of saving money and to be able to identify safe places to save money.	 Ask the students if they are saving their money and if they are, for what are they saving. Ask the students for examples of smart places to save their money. Ask them for examples of bad places to save their money. Explain to the students that there are safe places to save their money such as piggy banks and bank accounts.
Classroom Activity	8 minutes	To reinforce the concepts taught in this lesson through hands-on activities.	 Hand out the Safe to Save activity sheets. Have the students work on the sheets individually or in a group. Walk through the instructions of the activity, then walk through one example as a class and let the students begin working.
Conclusion	2 minutes		 Ask the students a few questions to review the lesson. Explain how important it is to save your money for the future and to save it in a safe place
